PENNSYLVANIA FAIRS ANIMAL HEALTH GUIDELINES

An animal owner or caretaker's **Verification of Veterinarian-Client-Patient Relationship** form must be presented upon arrival at all shows and fairs in Pennsylvania, including out-of-state entries. Official identification of animals is required. All animals must be free of infectious and contagious diseases and a statement of this is required on the certificate of veterinarian inspection.

RABBIT HEALTH RULES

1. Rabbits will be screened on arrival for health and show condition. No rabbits showing signs of contagious or infectious disease will be admitted to the show.
2. Department superintendents have the final judgment in resolving any dispute.

MAIL ALL RABBIT ENTRIES TO JACK TICKLE

Entry Fee - \$1.00 per rabbit Entries will be received from 12 to 6 PM Sunday. Exhibitors must provide their own feed. There will be a separate category for Mixed Breeds (Pets).

All rabbits are to be judged according to the latest standards of perfection of the American Rabbit Breeders Association. All pure-bred rabbits must have a PERMANENT EAR MARK. No sick or diseased rabbits will be admitted. No rabbits will be bred during the Fair. There will be Senior, Intermediate and Junior Classes in all breeds maturing at 10 pounds or over.

SECTION 2 - 4-H AND VOCATIONAL RABBITS

Each exhibitor must sign a statement as to the rabbit being free from known health disorders. Breeds sanctioned by the American Rabbit Breeders Association may be used. No rabbit may compete in more than one class.
